Since we just listed the fly plates in their most generic form in the book for space/cost considerations, here you can get more details of them for easier tying by using technology, since the fly plates are all shot in very large format files, which allow for the ultimate macro detailed inspection.

In addition, as the web site becomes a "real-time" aspect of Nexus, we will feature podcasts/blogs/interview features of the amazingly talented fly tiers that have contributed their art along with fly patterns I featured of my own creation.

The plates and individual flies/couplings featured throughout the book are from today's most talented creators, who are all listed with their info/web sites details

Body: Hareline UV Ice Dub –Peacock , Legs: partridge soft hackle with Json Sweden Realistic Nymph legs- N4, spotted with brown marker. Natural back: Golden wood duck. Synthetic Back: Wapsi Thin Skin: Mottled Oak: Natural, over layer of copper Flashabou. Eyes: Hareline small mono. Bead: copper

Author’s Super Sac Fry

Hook: Daiichi x452

thread: 2 types UTC 140 gray/brown, UNI Hot Pink Uni Stretch for blood vein of yoke sac

Yoke sac: tie Uni stretch on body of hook and whip finish off. Cut a strand of Otter’s soft milking egg sucker spawn-tangerine (<https://www.softmilkingegg.com/>), usually 5-6 egg layer strands. Pierce end of strand and sew it through the hook, with superglue coating the Uni stretch blood vein. Once evenly in place, secure the ends with Loon UV Clear Fly Finish and light. Leave space below the eye to start tying the fly with the gray/brown UTC thread.

Wings/layers-from bottom up:1. Hareline Ice Dub Shimmer Fringe: minnow mix pearl 2. Hareline ice dub/laser dub Fl. Pink 3 Grizzly hackle tips for parr marks 4. Hareline UV Ice Dub Light Olive 5. Hareline Senyo's UV Predator Wrap-Black Barred UV clear

Topping: Mirage Flashabou Blend-opal/purple

Eyes: Fish Skull Living eyes

Hook: Json Ultimate Dry Fly Hook, Thread: Ultra gray brown 140, tail: fine moose mane, Abdomen and body: Json Mayfly Foam bodies Hareline-gray, Ribbing: thread wrapped evenly to create segmentation along with fine marked black marker stripes, Thorax : foam cut in half with top and bottom to overlap thorax: Thorax hackle :grizzly, overlapped by foam top/bottom, Wings: Json Realistic Mayfly Wings natural non colored

The Ed Shenk's Old Original Ugly (the original “sculpin”)

Hook: 4 xl streamer (Mustad 79580, Daiichi 2220, etc.). sizes 4 to 10 with personal favs being size 8, then 6.

Thread: Danville Monocord or 6/0 Uni-Thread, black

Tail: black marabou, approximately as long as the hook shank

Body: black rabbit fur, spun in a dubbing loop, well picked out, and trimmed to shape, tapering towards tail and fairly flat on top and bottom. Body should take up about 2/3 thirds of the hook length.

Head: Two bunches of black deer hair spun and trimmed to shape. Shape should be fairly flat on top and bottom but broad from side to side. Leave a generous number of tips from the first bunch of deer hair on the top and sides for the “fins”.

This little streamer is tied with NO WEIGHT inside. Clamp a split shot onto to the leader just in front of the fly and “nymph” it. Many fish, when injured or dead exhibit this “black” color and trout eat them just as well as the live ones. Trout will pick this fly up off the bottom as if it were bait. Incredible! Also, Ed's sculpin can be tied in various color schemes of tan, brown, grey, or what ever. None will work any better than this one though

Double Deceiver recipes from Mark Loughead-Motown Fly

Motown Fly- Double Deceiver (all patterns just a function of switching material colors)

Hook Options:

Gamakatsu B10s/ Eagle Claw L253 / Mustad 3407 or equivalent

Thread:

Wapsi Ultra GSP 100

Tail:

Buck tail -Tied straight off the back of hook

First row down

I.C.S.I. Ant (Baltz)

Hook: Dry fly, (Daiichi #1170), sizes 10 to 20 (Daiichi #1100 from size 18, down) **Thread:** Danville 6/0 Flymaster. **Black Post:** Calf body hair, (orange, yellow, pink). Tie clump of hair onto hook shank just in front of the mid-point of shank. **Hackle:** Grizzly. Tie hackle directly to the hook shank just in front of the post with two turns of thread, then stand it up with the post and wind 6-10 turns of thread (depending up on fly size) around both the post and hackle, each turn above the previous one. Then wind thread back down post to hook with only a couple of turns. Try to tie the hackle in so that the dull underside is facing the post. **Body:** Black rabbit fur wound in three layers to build up rear hump. Fur must be tightly spun onto thread so it doesn't slip when building up the hump. Build rear hump, then front hump, leaving thread hanging just in front of the post. Wind the hackle five to seven turns from top to bottom with the concave (dull) side facing up and tie it off ON THE HOOK SHANK just in front of the post. This will not be so difficult if right handed tiers will wind the hackle COUNTER CLOCKWISE, left handers winding clockwise... Articulated (rotating) hackle pliers are also a godsend to parachute tiers. Apply a drop of head cement to thread windings from underside of finished fly.

I.C.S.I. Midge

Hook: Daiichi #1130, sizes 20 to 24 **Thread:** Danville Flymaster 6/0, olive. Attach thread to hook just behind the hook eye and wind an underbody to middle of hook bend, then trap the tag end of thread and wind back to post tie in position, leaving a thread loop to the rear of fly. **Post:** Float Viz (orange) or other synthetic yarn. The Float Viz is a fiber optic mater which really lights up outdoors. Tie it in UNDER the hook shank and post it up with couple of thread turns. **Hackle:** Grizzly. Tie hackle directly to the hook shank just in front of the post with two turns of thread, then stand it up with the post and wind 5 turns of thread around both the post and hackle, each turn above the previous one. Then wind quickly back to hook shank. Tie the hackle to the post so that the concave side is facing the post. **Body:** Krystal Flash, olive (or other color). Tie in 2-3 strands at base of post, wind rearward and reverse to wind forward. Tie it off at base of post. Coat it with Hard As Nails or UV goop. Snip

the loop to form two short tails (or just forget the whole thing; tails look cool though). Thorax: A blend of grey squirrel, CDC fibers (approx.. 50-50), adding a bit of Ice Dub, to taste. Dub a small, rough thorax around post, then wind hackle, each turn below previous ones. Right handed tiers should wind the hackle COUNTER CLOCKWISE and tie it off on the hook shank, just in front of the thorax with a four turn whip finish. No cement os necessary.

I.C.S.I. Midge (original)

Hook: Daiichi #1130, sizes 20-24 Thread: Danville Flymaster 6/0, black Post: Float Viz, orange. Tie it in on the UNDERSIDE of hook shank and post it up with couple of turns of thread. Hackle: Grizzly. Tie the hackle to the hook shank just in front of the post, then stand it up with the post and wrap 5 turns of thread around both together. Be sure that the dull underside is facing the post. Body: Rabbit fur. Black or other colors to suit. A favorite is olive thread with muskrat belly fur very thinly dubbed onto it. VERY THINLY dub fur onto thread and wrap from rear of body to front and cover the bump made when the post was tied in. Wind hackle in a counter clockwise direction (right handers), down the post and tie off on hook shank in front of the post. With a five turn whip finish no cement will be necessary.

CDC X-Caddis

Hook: Standard or 1x short dry fly, Daiichi 1170 or 1310, sizes 12-18 Thread: Danville Flymaster 6/0, olive brown or olive Tail: Z-Lon, ginger, light ginger (in smaller sizes). Body: Roughly (but tightly) dubbed Hare's Mask. Leave room for the wing. Under wing: CDC fibers. Use way more than you think you will need! Length to end of hook. Over Wing: Deer Hair just longer than CDC under wing. Sighter: Hot orange CdC, tied on top of wing. Dub a small neck of Squirrel/CdC/Ice Dub blend around wing tie down area and finish with a whip finish under deer hair at head of fly. Trim deer hair butts short to leave a head.

The amazing ParaNymph (Baltz) (vary the three slighter posts by color-orange/pink/yellow)

Hook: Dry fly (Daiichi #1170 to size 16 and Daiichi #1100 from 18 to 24) Thread: Danville Flymaster 6/0, olive Post: Calf body hair, orange, yellow, pink, and black. Each has its moments in varying lighting conditions. Tie it onto hook shank about one third of the way to bend. Hackle: Grizzly. Tie in hackle on hook shank directly in front of post with two turns of thread, then stand hackle up with post and wind them together with thread about 8-12 turns depending upon the fly size and planned number of turns of hackle. Attach hackle so that the dull underside is against the post. Tail: Z-Lon, olive brown. Split the strand to a size commensurate with hook

size. For Size 14 fly somewhat more than half of the thickness of the strand is about right. Body: Pure Hare's Mask with plenty of guard hairs. Dub the body tightly but with plenty of guard hairs sticking out all over the place. This is a sort of floating nymph platform and the wild hairs suggest legs, gills, etc. of a hatching nymph. Wind body to base of and around the post, then wind hackle, each turn under the previous ones. Seven turns of hackle is fairly standard on a size 14 hook. Right handed tiers will find that tying off the hackle on the hook shank directly in front of the post is greatly facilitated if right handed tiers will WIND THE HACKLE COUNTER CLOCKWISE. Left handers, obviously, should do the reverse. This will make a much stronger, more durable fly than tying off the thread ANY OTHER WAY. After hackle is tied off, dub a small amount of Hare's Mask onto hook to finish off the front of the fly and whip finish just behind the hook eye. No cement will be necessary with a good five turn whip finish.

Hippouros, Macedonian Fly

These fish feed upon a fly peculiar to the country, which hovers on the river. It is not like the flies found elsewhere, nor does it resemble a wasp in appearance, nor in shape would one justly describe it as a midge or a bee, yet it has something of each of these. In boldness it is like a fly, in size you might call it a midge, it imitates the color of a wasp, and it hums like a bee. The natives generally call it the Hippouros.

“Round the hook they twist scarlet wool and two wings are secured on this wool from the feathers which grow under the wattles of a cock, brought up to the proper colour with wax.” *Bibliotheca Piscatoria*, Westwood and Satchell, 1883.

How I tied this fly.

Hook- Antique blind eye size 10

Leader- Horse hair or silk worm gut

Body- Red wool

Wings- Honey colored badger neck feathers

Jock Scott, Variant between and Kelson's version, *The Salmon Fly 1895* and T.E. Pryce-Tannatt ,
How to Dress Salmon Flies 1914

Hook- 5/0 Noble DS, Ronn Lucas (Can be tied on any salmon hook for your application or to your liking)

Tip-Fine silver tinsel

Tag-Yellow silk

Tail- Golden pheasant tail veiled with Indian crow

Butt- Ostrich herl, black

Body- Rear half yellow silk ribbed with fine silver, veiled top and bottom with six toucan feathers (3 above and 3 below), and butted with black ostrich herl in the middle. Front half is black silk ribbed with broad flat silver tinsel and black hackle.

Throat- Speckled Gallina (guinea fowl)

Under wing- White tipped turkey

Main wing- Peacock wing, yellow, scarlet, blue swan or turkey, bustard, floricane and golden pheasant tail all married. Two strands of peacock sward over. Narrow married strips of teal and barred wood duck at the side.

Sides- Jungle cock

Cheeks-Chatterer

Roof- Bronze mallard and a topping of golden pheasant crest over all.

Horns- Blue and yellow macaw
